

**Scallop Top Pleated Panel** contains:

- Instructions to make a pleated panel with a graceful scalloped top edge, accented with microcord.
- Choice of pleat styles: inverted pleats or french triple pleats.
- Pattern pieces for scalloped top, including facing pieces.
- Instructions included for single width panels may be modified for multiple widths. One panel spans 25" after pleating plus 3" return.

*Suggested Fabrics:* Any light to medium weight fabrics. Examples include cottons, silks, linens, or other natural fibers. Heavy or thick fabrics, such as upholstery fabrics, are not suitable.

*Yardages for one (1) panel:*

Solid Fabrics: Face fabric: Finished panel length plus 20"  
Microcord: 1½ yards (will cord additional panels)  
Lining: Finished panel length plus 8"  
Interlining: Finished panel length plus 10" (optional)

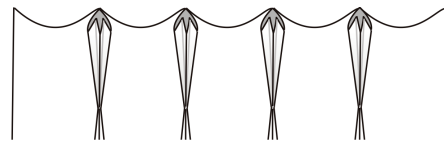
Print Fabrics: Face fabric: Finished panel length plus 20", plus repeat.  
Microcord: 1½ yards (will cord additional panels)  
Lining: Finished panel length plus 8"  
Interlining: Finished panel length plus 10" (optional)

*Supplies:* 4" buckram for header, drapery pins, drapery weights, thread, ¼" cotton cord for micro-cording. A t-square and drapery table or other large flat table for assembling panels is highly recommended.

*Difficulty Level:* Intermediate
