

Top Down/Bottom Up Tucked Roman Shade contains:

- Instructions to make a top down/bottom up roman shade. This shade features tucks to the back for the shade ribs, and an attached valance.

Suggested Fabrics: Light to medium weight drapery and upholstery fabrics, such as cottons, silks, velvets, chenilles, polyesters.

Yardages: Fabric, lining and interlining* (interlining optional)

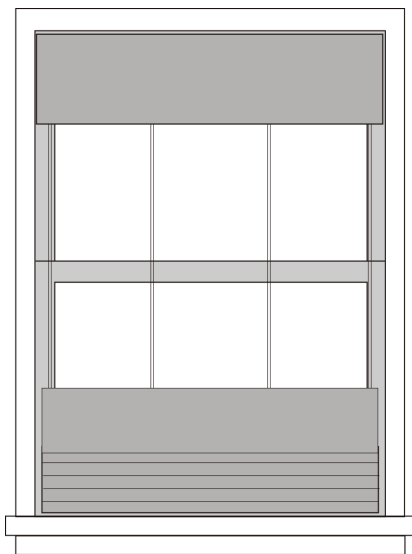
Shades 12" to 48" wide, up to 96" long: One Cut @ Finished shade length plus the vertical repeat, plus 36" (yardage suggestions accurate for fabrics with centered horizontal repeats) *Shades 43" to 48" wide require an additional 13" cut for returns on the valance

Shades 48" to 96" wide, up to 96" long: Two Cuts @ Finished shade length plus the vertical repeat, plus 36" (yardage suggestions accurate for fabrics with centered horizontal repeats)

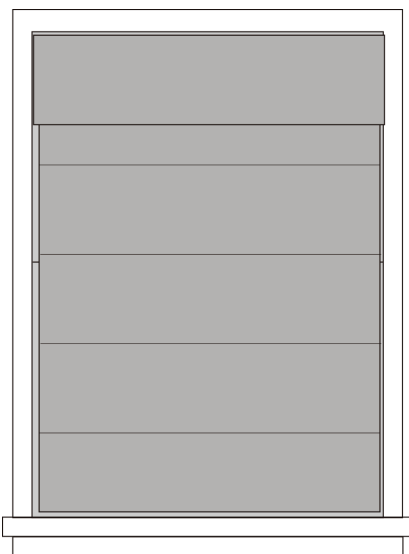
Supplies: Cordlocks (2 for each shade), shade cord, cord drops, rings, $\frac{1}{4}$ " shade ribs or dowels, oval wooden shade rod, $\frac{1}{16}$ " aluminum weight bar, 1" x 3" lumber, round screw eyes, $\frac{3}{4}$ " wood screws (4)

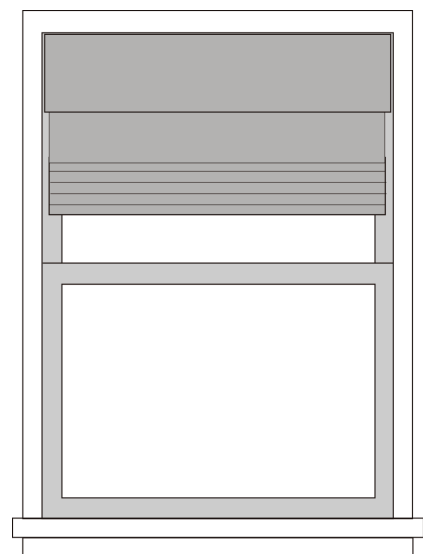
Top Down Mode
